

3.6 Saddles

A saddle includes the girth, surcingle, leathers or webs, and stirrup irons of a design approved by the Stewards or the Club.



Every jockey is responsible for the serviceable condition of the saddle which he/she uses, provided that in the case of an apprentice jockey the responsibility rests with the apprentice and the trainer to whom he/she is allocated.

In the case of a saddle used in training, each trainer is responsible for the serviceable condition of such gear.
