3.3 Sheepskin Cheek Pieces / Shadow Roll / Sheepskin Browband

Sheepskin cheek pieces shall not be less than 200 mm in length and be of a reasonable thickness, which ensures it has sufficient material to aid horses, whilst allowing adequate peripheral vision. A shadow roll and a sheepskin browband must also be of a reasonable thickness.

Sheepskin cheek pieces must be attached to the cheek strap of the bridle.

A shadow roll must be positioned no further up the nasal bone than half way between the nostrils and eyes.


A sheepskin browband must be attached to the brow band of the bridle.

A shadow roll, sheepskin cheek pieces and a sheepskin browband shall not be worn in races by a horse wearing pacifiers or pacifiers with cowls.
